Use this form to submit a claim for **reimbursement** under the *Salcedo* settlement for a connecting rod bearing or main bearing failure if you can satisfy all of the following criteria:

1. You are a current or former owner or lessee of a model year 2012 through 2017 Subaru Impreza WRX and STi vehicles equipped with an EJ-series 2.5-liter turbocharged engine, manufactured between October 11, 2011, and November 16, 2016. These vehicles will have vehicle identification numbers (VIN) ending with CG203168 and up for 5-door models, and CG006225 through H9826807 for 4-door models (“Settlement Class Vehicle”);
2. You have not excluded yourself from the Settlement;
3. You presented your Settlement Class Vehicle to an authorized Subaru retailer for repair of a connecting rod bearing or main bearing related failure;
4. You incurred out-of-pocket expenses related to a Qualifying Repair addressing a connecting rod bearing or main bearing failure.

Under the Settlement, you will receive a warranty extension of the vehicle’s Powertrain Limited Warranty to 8 years or 100,000 miles as related to any issues of materials or workmanship related to the engine’s connecting rod bearings and main bearings. You may also be eligible to receive reimbursement for certain out-of-pocket expenses related to a Qualifying Repair addressing a connecting rod bearing or main bearing failure. Reimbursements for repairs performed by non-Subaru repair facilities and for rental car expenses are subject to limits as noted in Section VI. of the Settlement Agreement.

NOTE: Before filling out this claim form, please review the Notice of Class Settlement carefully to determine if you qualify for reimbursement under this settlement.

You do not need to fill out or send in this claim form to obtain the warranty extension or its benefits. The warranty extension has been automatically applied to all qualifying vehicles.

Claims will not be processed, and no reimbursements will be issued, until the Settlement has received Final Approval from the Court, and all appeals from the Court's order approving the Settlement have been resolved or the appeal periods have expired.
